<u>City Maintenance Report</u>: Raethz stated the gates at the rubble site were replaced, due to someone hitting them. The rubble site will open again this week, but close as the weather gets colder. They are trying to fill some bigger potholes with some crushed concrete. Some snow removal equipment is getting worked on as well.

<u>Mayors Report</u>: Mayor Roseland stated the county now has fuel pumps and the city is able to purchase fuel from them at the government rate. Roseland also stated he would like the tourism committee to start working on the brochures again.

Police Report: No report

Economic Development: Cramer said they still have some interest in the industrial lots and another house is planned next summer at the Westside addition. Cramer stated they have the quit claim deed ready to transfer the lot that Hope's Park is on to the city.

<u>Airport Environmental Assessment Update:</u> Brooke Edgar with Helms and Associates informed the council that the FAA approved the airport environmental assessment today. The assessment will be available to the public on the city's website, at city hall and the airport GA terminal.

Development Corporation – Transit Lot: Cramer stated Faulk County Transit had asked the council about donating a lot by the swimming pool a few months ago. After some discussion a lot was suggested at the 4H ground where the old bathroom sits. After some discussion the council was open to the idea and said that the 4H leaders will need to be talked to.

2020.11.120 Storm Shelter Update & Pay Requests: Raethz stated the substantial completion certificate was signed a few weeks ago and the contractors should be finishing up this week. Raethz and Bauer will do a final walk through. Pay request from Civil Design Inc for \$1,585.00 was presented. Councilwoman Bartholomew moved, seconded by Fischer to approve the pay request. Roll call vote was taken with all voting aye. Motion carried.

TAP Sidewalk Project: Cramer stated the sidewalk project is complete. Bauer stated she will be sending invoices to the homeowners, they will be assessed \$1.00 per square footage of their property. Bauer said she will work with homeowners if they need to make payment arrangements.
