2023.5.55 Faulk County Transit: Dwight Hossle with Faulk County Transit asked the council if they would deed Lot 1 in Faulk County Transit Second Addition to the Faulk County Transit group. They plan to remodel the current building to store the transit bus and house an office. Hossle said for grant purposes it would help if the Transit owned the land the building was on. Hossle suggested a restrictive deed, which would state if the land was sold it would go back to the city. Councilman Hadrick moved, seconded by Fischer to approve the sale on Lot 1 in Faulk County Transit Second Addition for \$0.00. Unanimous.

Faulkton Tourism: Stacy Hadrick and Stephanie Kaiser with the Faulkton Tourism committee presented the council with a tourism opportunity to work with a marketing firm, Fresh Produce, to help establish a marketing plan and marketing content for the City of Faulkton. Hadrick stated the quote was \$30,000-\$35,000, which she has a grant from the State for ½ of that cost. Bauer also received a grant from the Department of Tourism for \$3,618 for marketing.

Hadrick asked the Council if they would be willing to pay the difference. Kaiser stated the Arts Council also will commit \$3,000 - \$5,000 towards the quote. That leaves the City contributing \$10,000 or less. After some discussion the council was interested but would like the full council to make the decision at the June meeting and the issue was tabled.

Park Mural: Roseland stated the arts council has picked an artist to paint a mural on the storm shelter. They would like an interactive mural painted. He stated they will share the design with the council to approve before its painted.

2023.5.56 Liquor License Transfer Application Retail (on-sale): This being the time and place so stated in the public notice, an application for Retail (on-sale) liquor license was reviewed from ADD01 (d/b/a Blondie's). No one from the public was there to comment. Motion was made by Councilman Geiger, seconded by Fischer to approve said application. Unanimous.
