The Faulkton City Council met in special session on April 17, 2023 in the City Hall meeting room with Finance Officer Emily Bauer and the following council members present: Linda Bartholomew, Chris Geiger, Ryan Kast and Steve Wanner. Open Forum: Nobody spoke.
